

Mrs. Ellen Mahony

Mrs. Ellen Mahony, who died at her home, 80 Lawrence street, Wednesday morning last, suffered a paralytic stroke a week previous. Mrs. Mahony was one of the oldest residents of Yonkers. She was born in Killarney, County Kerry, Ireland, in 1836 and was educated in the famous Ursuline convent at that place.

She came to America 63 years ago and settled in New York City. She was married in St. Stephen's church to Abel Mahony, in January, 1852.

Mrs. Mahony has been a resident of Yonkers for the past 30 years and was a parishioner of St. Mary's church for most of that period. She is survived by six children, Daniel J. Mahony, Abel F. Mahony, James V. Mahony, Mrs. Henry V. Doyle and the Misses Margaret and Ellen Mahony; also by 12 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

The funeral will take place to-morrow morning, with requiem Mass in St. Denis' church at 10 o'clock, and the interment will be in St. Mary's cemetery.
